

## **LR 28.1 INTERPRETERS**

### **A. Responsibility for Obtaining.**

When interpreters are required in criminal proceedings, the clerk of court will obtain the services of certified or otherwise qualified interpreters for all court proceedings. If counsel for either party believes that interpreter services for court proceedings are needed for more than an hour, counsel will ~~give~~ notify the clerk of court, preferably at least two weeks' ~~notice prior to the time the~~ interpreter services are to be provided. For all other purposes, a party requiring the services of an interpreter must obtain his/her own interpreting services. If the defendant is indigent, prior court approval to hire an interpreter is required as specified in 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(e) and Volume 7 of the Guide to Judiciary Policy found at <http://www.uscourts.gov>
