A "bad attitude" does not constitute aggravated circumstances.

\*\* All drug violations, with the exception of less than 1 ounce of marijuana in possession, and assault or battery must be coordinated with the United States Attorney before any charges are brought or a Mandatory Appearance **(MA)** is required.


