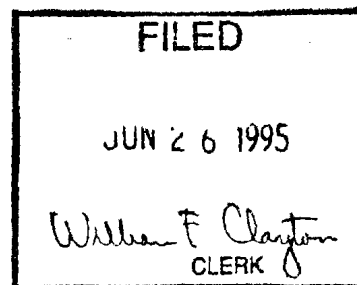


**STANDING ORDER**

It appears to the Court that it would be beneficial to child victims to receive compensation from the South Dakota Crimes Victims' Compensation Fund for their losses as victims of federal crimes or alleged federal crimes. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS


ORDERED that the United States Attorney's Office and federal law enforcement agencies may disclose necessary information, concerning a child who is the victim of an alleged federal crime, to the South Dakota Victims' Compensation Commission, and that commission agents and employees, to facilitate the South Dakota Victims' Compensation Commission in processing and considering for reimbursement a federal child victim's claim. This disclosure, in the opinion of the Court, is necessary for the welfare and well being of the child and is allowed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3509(d)(4).
