Except for extraordinary circumstances brought to the court's attention prior to the commencement of a jury trial, it is hereby

ORDERED that every defendant in a criminal case shall be allowed to wear civilian clothing during the course of a jury trial. This clothing shall be provided to the United States Marshals Service each morning of trial by the defendant's attorney.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant shall appear before the jury without shackles and the United States Marshals Service shall take appropriate measures to ensure the jurors do not observe the defendant in shackles in or out of the courtroom.
