New Judges take the Bench. There have been some recent changes on the federal bench in South Dakota. On June 5, 2024, Judge Camela Theeler was sworn in as a district judge for the District of South Dakota. Judge Theeler replaces Judge Jeffrey Viken, who retired last October. Judge Theeler's duty station is Rapid City. On June 6, 2024, Judge Eric Schulte was sworn in as a district judge. He fills a vacancy created by Judge Karen Schreier, who is moving to senior status. Judge Schulte's duty station is Pierre, whereas Chief Judge Lange is now based in Sioux Falls.
