District of Iowa are authorized to serve in the adjoining District of South Dakota, and the
full time and recalled magistrate judges in the District of South Dakota are authorized to
serve in the adjoining Northern District of Iowa.

This authorization being given for the purpose of carrying out any of the duties of magistrate judges specified in 28 U.S.C., 18 U.S.C., and the Local Rules and administrative or general orders of the Northern District of Iowa and the District of South Dakota and is made by concurrence of a majority of the judges of each of the district courts involved.
