By direction of the United States District Court for the District of South Dakota,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3153(c), and except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, information obtained in the course of performing pretrial services functions in relation to a particular accused shall be used only for the purposes of a bail determination and shall otherwise be confidential. Each pretrial services report shall be made available to the attorney for the accused and the attorney for the Government.


The pretrial services report will be made available to the attorney for the accused and the attorney for the Government either through the Clerk's Case Management and Electronic Case Files (CM/ECF) or by hand-delivery of a physical copy by an employee of the Probation and Pretrial Services Office.

When the pretrial services report is accessed by the attorneys electronically, copies of the report may be reproduced. Copies of the pretrial services report may be retained by the attorneys and shall be used only for the purpose of bail determinations, including fixing conditions of pretrial release.

The Clerk of Court will have the CM/ECF system display a notice indicating the report is not a public record and its content may not be disclosed to unauthorized individuals. When the pretrial services report is provided by hard copy to the attorney for the accused and the attorney for the Government, the Probation and Pretrial Services Office will provide a header on the first page advising the authorized attorneys the report is not a public record and its content may not be disclosed to unauthorized individuals.
