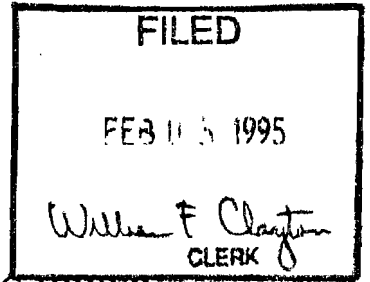


STANDING ORDER


