STANDING ORDER

Given the limited availability of staff of the United States Marshals Service to transport prisoners to secure locations for the purposes of cooperative debriefings either pursuant to a plea agreement or in anticipation of a plea agreement,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that upon the request of the United States Attorney's Office, the United States Marshal may release into the custody of any other federal law enforcement officer, a prisoner presently in the custody of the Marshal upon federal charges, for periods not to exceed eight (8) hours for the purpose of cooperative debriefing. Such a release shall be conducted consistent with United States Marshals Service standards for transportation and security, and any such prisoner shall be immediately returned to the custody of the Marshal upon the completion of the debriefing.
